ARRIVING BY PLANE

The international airport of Firenze Peretola 'Amerigo Vespucci', is located in the north-west suburban area of Florence. There are many airlines arriving there and connecting the city to some of the most important European airports. The airport is only 6 km from the city centre, which can be easily reached by taxi or with the Tramvia T2 Line from Peretola Airport to Firenze Santa Maria Novella train station (around 15 minutes). Then from there, it is possibile to reach Stazione Leopolda with the Tramvia T1, direction to Villa Costanza, from Alamanni Stazione (Santa Maria Novella train station) to Porta al Prato – Leopolda which is just 1 stop from the railway station.

ARRIVING BY TRAIN

The main central railway station of Santa Maria Novella (one of the most important railway junctions as well as an interchange point of Florence public transportation) is located not far from the venue of the event. From the railway station, it is possibile to reach Stazione Leopolda with the Tramvia T1, direction to Villa Costanza, from Alamanni Stazione to Porta al Prato - Leopolda which is just 1 stop from the railway station.
